- Additional ideas:**
- Tell students to get two pieces of large paper. On one piece of paper they draw a cross and on the second piece of paper they should draw a tick.
 - Tell them that you are going to ask questions to the class and the students have to listen and hold up the piece of paper that best corresponds to their answer. For example say, *Did you play basketball yesterday?* (Students answer by holding up the cross or tick.) *Did you walk to school yesterday?* (Students answer by holding up the cross or tick.)
